## Day 1 - Opening Day Programme

The first day of the Transnational Project Meeting marked the official launch of the Environmentalists in the Workforce of the Future (EcoWorkFuture) project and was hosted by Lycée Professionnel Augustin Hébert. The programme focused on project orientation, partner introduction, institutional exchange, and local educational best practices.

### Morning Session – Project Kick-off and Institutional Activities

The day began with the pick-up of project partners from the hotel at 09:00, followed by their arrival at Lycée Augustin Hébert.



The opening session included:

- Welcome and registration of participants
- An official opening presentation by the host institution
- A detailed presentation of the project objectives, work packages, and overall implementation timeline
- Introduction of partner organisations, allowing participants to share their institutional backgrounds, expertise, and expected contributions
- An overview of artificial intelligence (AI) and data literacy components integrated into the project, highlighting their role in sustainability-oriented vocational education and training

This session ensured that all partners developed a shared understanding of the project's vision, structure, and responsibilities from the very beginning.

## Afternoon Session – Digital Education and Innovation

In the afternoon, a dedicated session on Information Technologies in Education was delivered by Meriç Demercioğlu.

The presentation focused on:

- The role of digital tools and educational technologies in modern vocational education
- The integration of digital competences and innovation into teaching and learning processes
- Practical examples of technology-enhanced learning environments

This session supported the project's objectives related to digital transformation and innovation in VET.

## Micro-Folie & Media Fab Lab Visit

At 15:00, participants attended a meeting at the Micro-Folie – Media Fab Lab in Évreux, where they explored:

- Digital cultural and creative learning spaces
- Innovative media production tools
- Examples of community-based digital education and informal learning

This visit inspired discussions on how similar creative and digital spaces could be adapted for vocational education and sustainability-focused activities within the project.

## Cultural and City Visit

The first day concluded with a free visit and city tour of Évreux, allowing partners to experience the local environment, culture, and social context. This activity further strengthened interpersonal connections and intercultural understanding among project partners.

## Day 2 - EcoWorkFuture Visits

The second day of the Transnational Project Meeting focused on study visits, industry exposure, and cultural exploration, allowing participants to observe sustainability practices in real-life contexts while strengthening intercultural understanding.

The day began with a city-based visit and seasonal cultural experience, enabling participants to engage informally and experience local traditions. This activity supported cultural exchange and helped build stronger connections among project partners.

Later in the day, participants visited the Schneider Electric, where they explored the company's approach to sustainability, energy efficiency, and digital innovation. The visit provided valuable insights into how green technologies and smart industrial solutions are applied in practice. Participants observed real-world examples demonstrating how innovation and digitalisation contribute to the development of a more sustainable workforce.

This visit was highly relevant to the EcoWorkFuture project, as it illustrated the strong link between vocational education, labour market needs, and environmental responsibility.







In the afternoon, the group took part in a cultural walking tour of Paris, including iconic landmarks such as the Eiffel Tower, Champs-Élysées, and major Parisian boulevards. This activity encouraged reflection, informal discussion, and cultural immersion, complementing the educational aspects of the day.

The day concluded with a networking dinner in a traditional Parisian restaurant, offering participants an opportunity to continue discussions in an informal setting, share experiences, and further strengthen cooperation among partner organisations.
